

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how The Bowgie Inn uses and protects any information that you give us when you use our website. The Bowgie Inn is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using our website, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

What Info We May Collect and what we do with it

We may collect the following information: name and email address, contact information including postal address and postcode.

We require this information to maximise our service to you. We may use the information to occasionally send you a promotional email about our new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting. We may, on rare occasions, also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. This would only ever be by email. You can of course elect not to receive communication from us at any point and we absolutely promise that we will never pass any information to third parties.

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor

its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We only use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
